Subject:	Draft Council Conclusions on organised domestic burglary = Adoption

1. Alerted by the considerably increase in property crime committed in Europe by highly mobile organised crime groups, the German and French delegations proposed draft Council conclusions on organised domestic burglary, which were discussed by the COSI Support Group on 12 September 2016.
2. The Council decided in 2013 that "organised property crime committed by Mobile Organised Crime Groups" (MOCG) was one of the EU crime priorities for the period 2014-2017¹ in the framework of the EU Policy Cycle for organised and serious international crime.
3. The draft Council conclusions contain a series of measures to address organised domestic burglary and build upon the work carried out within the framework of the EU Policy Cycle, notably the Operational Action Plan "Organised Property Crime".
