Subject:	Draft Council conclusions on setting the EU's priorities for organised and serious international crime between 2018 and 2021

---

1. The 2018-2021 EU Policy Cycle for organised and serious international crime<sup>1</sup> requires that a Policy Advisory Document (PAD) be produced on the basis of the EU Serious and Organised Crime Threat Assessment (SOCTA) 2017 and considering other strategic papers and assessments and policies. The PAD<sup>2</sup>, which was produced by the Presidency together with the Commission, builds upon the (executive summary) of the EU SOCTA 2017<sup>3</sup> and aims to prepare the draft Council conclusions setting the EU's new priorities for the fight against serious and organised crime between 2014 to 2017.
